

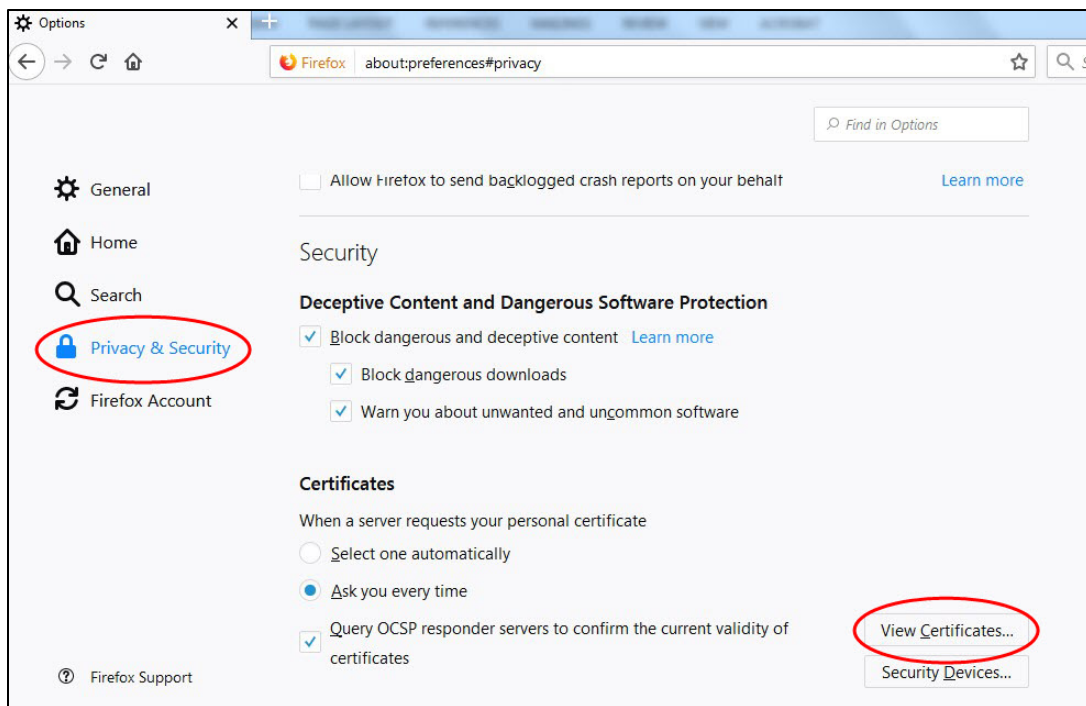
How to replace your Symantec certificates

For Internet Explorer and Google Chrome users

- Go to: digicert.com/digicert-root-certificates.htm#roots
- Locate the 'DigiCert Global Root G2' certificate under the Root Certificates header and click Download.
- Locate the file.
- Right click and choose Install Certificate.
- Open the file and follow the Windows Certificate wizard installation and let it choose where to place it.

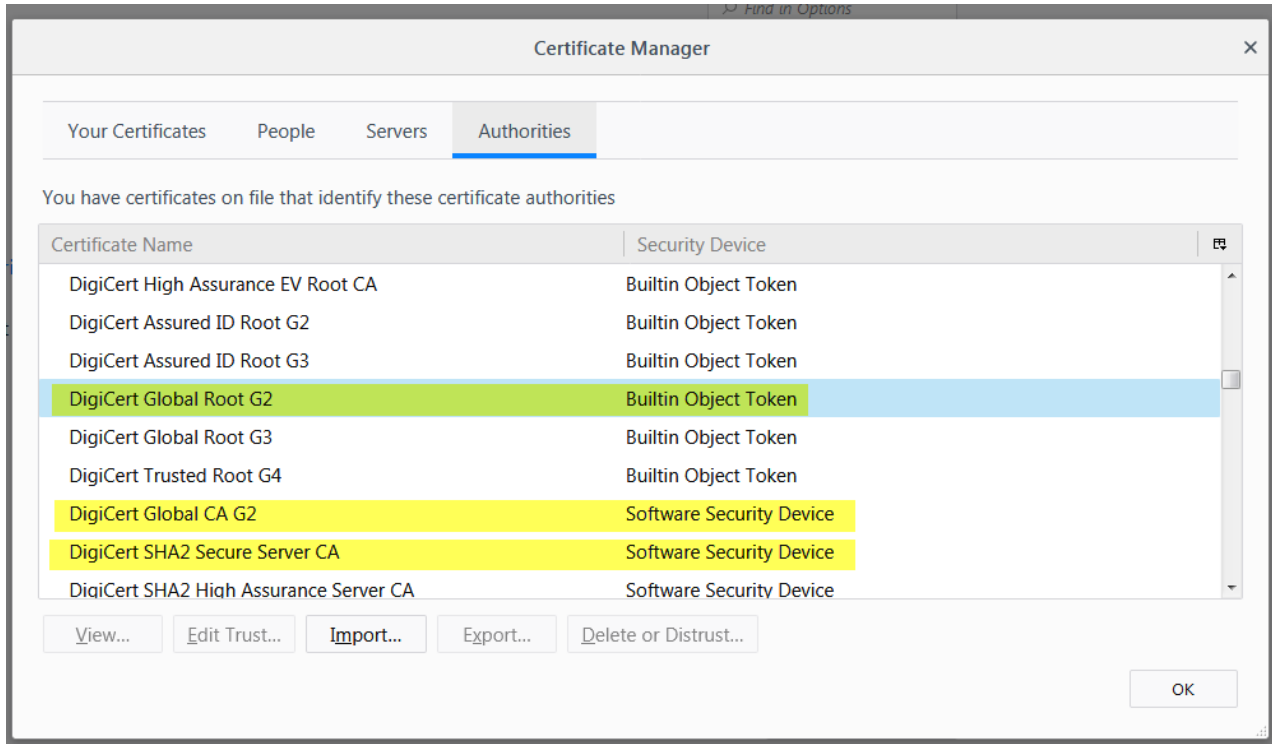
For Mozilla Firefox users

- Go to: digicert.com/digicert-root-certificates.htm#roots
- Locate these three certificates one by one and click on Download.
 - "DigiCert Global Root G2"
 - "DigiCert SHA2 Secure Server CA"
 - "DigiCert Global CA G2"
- Validate the three above certificates are loaded in Firefox:
 - Go to Tools-> Options-> Privacy & Security-> View Certificates



How to replace your Symantec certificates

- Ensure these three certificates are available under Authorities tab:

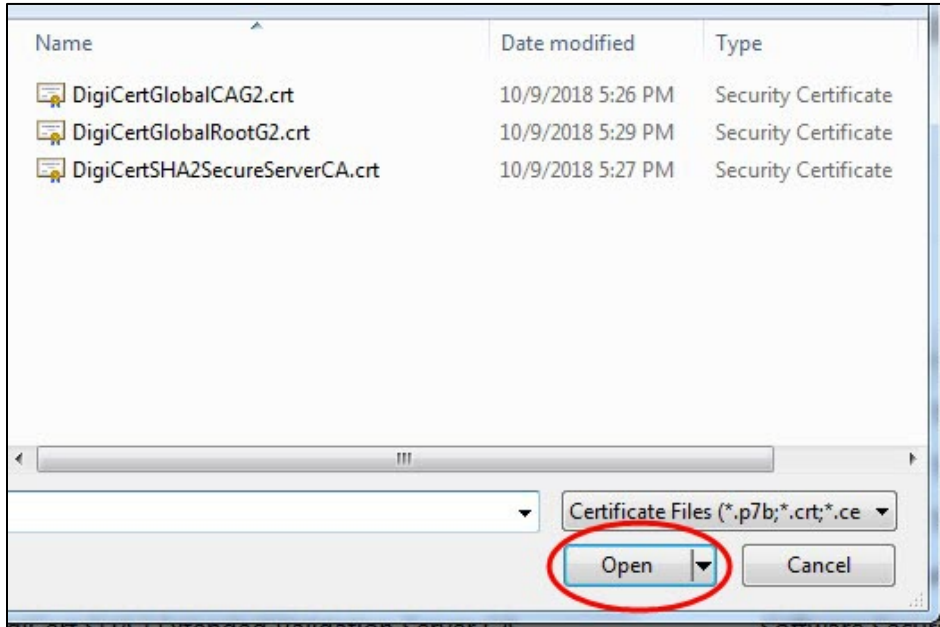


- If any of the three certificates are missing:
 - Click Import



How to replace your Symantec certificates

- Browse the download folder and select the missing certificate. Click Open.



- Check "Trust this CA to identify websites." and click OK to import.
